5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 62-3(23) is amended by adding a new subparagraph to read:
7	"h. The term 'public utility' shall not include the resale of electricity
8	by (i) a campground operated primarily to serve transient
9	occupants, or (ii) a marina; provided that (i) the campground or
10	marina charges no more than the actual cost of the electricity
11	supplied to it, (ii) the amount of electricity used by each
12	campsite or marina slip occupant is measured by an individual
13	metering device, (iii) the applicable rates are prominently
14	displayed at or near each campsite or marina slip, and (iv) the
15	campground or marina only resells electricity to campsite or
16	marina slip occupants."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
