A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE EDGECOMBE COUNTY ABC BOARD TO CONTRACT WITH THE DIVISION OF ALCOHOL LAW ENFORCEMENT FOR LOCAL ALCOHOL LAW ENFORCEMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 18B-805(c) reads as rewritten:

"(c) Other Statutory Distributions. – After making the distributions required by subsection (b), a local board shall make the following quarterly distributions from the remaining gross receipts:

- (1) Before making any other distribution under this subsection, the local board shall set aside the clear proceeds of the three and one-half percent (3 1/2%) markup provided for in G.S. 18B-804(b)(5) and the bottle charge provided for in G.S. 18B-804(b)(6b), to be distributed as part of the remaining gross receipts under subsection (e) of this section.
- (2) The local board shall spend for law enforcement an amount set by the board which shall be at least five percent (5%) of the gross receipts remaining after the distribution required by subdivision (1). Notwithstanding the provisions of any local act, this provision shall apply to all local boards. The local board may contract with the Division of Alcohol Law Enforcement to provide the law enforcement required by this subdivision.
- (3) The local board shall spend, or pay to the county commissioners to spend, for the purposes stated in subsection (h), an amount set by the

1 board which shall be at least seven percent (7%) of the gross receipts
2 remaining after the distribution required by subdivision (1). This
3 provision shall not be applicable to a local board which is subject to a
4 local act setting a different distribution."

5 Sec. 2. This act applies to the Edgecombe County ABC Board only.

6 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
