1 A JOINT RESOLUTION HONORING S. A. HOLLEMAN, THE FIRST MAYOR OF  
2 THE TOWN OF ELON COLLEGE, AND THE FOUNDERS OF THE TOWN OF  
3 ELON COLLEGE ON THE TOWN'S ONE-HUNDREDTH ANNIVERSARY.

4       Whereas, the Town of Elon College, formerly known as the Village of Mill  
5 Point, was founded on April 7, 1893, near the tracks of the North Carolina Railroad; and  
6       Whereas, the first mayor of the Town of Elon College was S. A. Holleman;  
7 and

8       Whereas, the Town of Elon College, the proud home of Elon College and  
9 Elon Homes for Children, has been an integral part of Alamance County, especially as a  
10 cultural and educational center; and

11       Whereas, a number of dedicated volunteers have taken time out of their busy  
12 schedules to plan and implement many special events in recognition of the town's  
13 centennial; and

14       Whereas, several area businesses have joined with the town by contributing to  
15 the centennial celebration in order to make it a success;

16 Now, therefore, be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

17       Section 1. The General Assembly honors the memory of S. A. Holleman, the  
18 first mayor of the Town of Elon College, and the founders of the Town of Elon College.  
19 The General Assembly further recognizes and congratulates the Town of Elon College  
20 on its one-hundredth anniversary and wishes the town and its citizens much success in  
21 their centennial year.

1                   Sec. 2. The Secretary of State shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution  
2 to the Mayor of the Town of Elon College and the Alamance County Board of County  
3 Commissioners.

4                   Sec. 3. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
