2	AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING THE DEFINITION OF
3	NEGLECTED JUVENILE.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 7A-517(21) reads as rewritten:
6	"(21) Neglected Juvenile. – A juvenile who does not receive proper care,
7	supervision, or discipline from his the juvenile's parent, guardian,
8	custodian, or caretaker; or who has been abandoned; or who is not
9	provided necessary medical eare or other care; or who is not provided
10	necessary remedial eare care; recognized under State law, or who lives in
11	an environment injurious to his welfare, the juvenile's welfare; or who
12	has been placed for care or adoption in violation of law. In
13	determining whether a juvenile is a neglected juvenile, it is relevant
14	whether that juvenile lives in a home where another juvenile has died
15	as a result of abuse or neglect or lives in a home where another
16	juvenile has been subjected to sexual abuse or severe physical abuse
17	by an adult who regularly lives in the home."
18	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1993, and applies to
19	adjudications for acts or omissions on or after that date.
