SCHOOLS.

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Education the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the purchase of magnetometers to screen for weapons in the public schools. The State Board of Education shall allocate the funds to the local school administrative units that request magnetometers and that have the greatest need for them. The Department of Public Instruction shall provide guidance to local school administrative units on how to use magnetometers to make the schools safer for students.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
