A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE PRIORITIES FOR PAYMENT OF LIABILITY
CLAIMS WHEN MORE THAN ONE INSURANCE POLICY COVERS A
RENTED VEHICLE.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. G.S. 20-279.21 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
"(<u>c1</u>) When a vehicle is rented and is covered by more than one liability insurance
policy, the priority for payment of liability claims shall be:
(1) The liability policy or policies, if any, of any unauthorized driver of
the vehicle, who was driving the vehicle when the accident upon
which the liability claim arose;
(2) The liability policy or policies, if any, of any authorized driver of the
vehicle, who was driving the vehicle when the accident upon which
the liability claim arose;
(3) The liability policy or policies, if any, of the rental company."
Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1993.
