A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO PERMIT INCREASED WEIGHTS FOR HAULING AGRICULTURAL
COMMODITIES.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. G.S. 20-118 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
"(c1) A vehicle used for hauling agricultural commodities within 35 miles of the
farm on which they are grown shall be exempt from subsections (b) and (e) of this
section when the vehicle has a gross weight of no more than 88,000 pounds, a single
axle weight of no more than 22,000 pounds, and a tandem axle weight of no more than
42,000 pounds; is a five-axle combination with a gross weight of no more than 88,000
pounds; or is a four-axle combination with a tandem axle weight of 42,000 pounds.
This exemption shall not apply to any vehicle whose axle weight or axle spacing would
not be permissible under G.S. 20-115 through G.S 20-118 when crossing any bridge
constituting a part of any public road."
Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
