G.S. 105-164.3(8b) reads as rewritten: 6 "(8b) 'Motor vehicle' means a vehicle that is designed primarily for use upon 7 the highways and is either self-propelled or propelled by a self-8 propelled vehicle, but does not include: 9 A moped as defined in G.S. 20-4.01(27)(d1). 10 Special mobile equipment as defined in G.S. 20-4.01(44). 11 b. A tow dolly that is exempt from motor vehicle title and 12 c. registration requirements under G.S. 20-51(10) or (11). 13 A farm tractor or other implement of husbandry. 14 d. A manufactured home. home, a mobile office, or a mobile 15 e. classroom. 16 f Road construction or road maintenance machinery or 17 18 equipment." Sec. 2. G.S. 105-164.4(a) is amended by adding the following subdivision to 19 20 read: "(1e) The rate of three percent (3%) applies to the sales price of each mobile 21 classroom or mobile office sold at retail, including all accessories 22

attached to the mobile classroom or mobile office when it is delivered

to the purchaser. The maximum tax is one thousand five hundred
