7	"(13) Unprocessed forest products. – Vehicles transporting unprocessed
8	forest products may exceed the axle group weight limits set in this
9	section by up to ten percent (10%), subject to a maximum gross weight
10	of 80,000 pounds and upon payment of a fee of one hundred fifty
11	dollars (\$150.00) to the Division. This exception does not apply to
12	vehicles on interstate highways."
13	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
