A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT SPACE WITHIN A COSMETIC ART SHOP  
RENTED BY AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR IS NOT A SEPARATE  
COSMETIC ART SHOP.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 88-4 reads as rewritten:

**"§ 88-4. Beauty parlor, etc.**

'Cosmetic art shop,' 'beauty parlor,' or 'hairdressing establishment' is any building, or part thereof wherein cosmetic art is practiced, and a 'beauty school,' 'beauty college,' or 'beauty academy' is any building or part thereof wherein cosmetic art is taught. Booth space rented by an independent contractor within a cosmetic art shop is not a separate cosmetic art shop."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
