2 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE GENERAL STATUTES TO INCLUDE TRAINING
3 FOR INCINERATOR OPERATORS OF SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT
4 FACILITIES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 130A-309.25 reads as rewritten:

7 "**§ 130A-309.25. Training of operators of solid waste management facilities.**

8 (a) The Department shall establish qualifications for, and encourage the
9 development of training programs for, operators of incinerators, operators of landfills,
10 coordinators of local recycling programs, and other solid waste management facilities.

11 (b) The Department shall work with accredited community colleges, vocational
12 technical centers, State universities, and private institutions in developing educational
13 materials, courses of study, and other such information to be made available for persons
14 seeking to be trained as operators of solid waste management facilities.

15 (c) A person may not perform the duties of an operator of a solid waste
16 management facility after 1 January 1996, unless he has completed an operator training
17 course approved by the Department. An owner of a solid waste management facility
18 may not employ any person to perform the duties of an operator unless such person has
19 completed an approved solid waste management facility operator training course.

20 (d) The Commission may adopt rules and minimum standards to effectuate the
21 provisions of this section and to ensure the safe, healthy, and lawful operation of solid
22 waste management facilities. The Commission may establish, by rule, various
23 classifications for operators to address the need for differing levels of training required

1 to operate various types of solid waste management facilities due to different operating
2 requirements at the facilities.

3 (e) In developing training programs for incinerator operators under this section,
4 the Department shall establish and consult with ad hoc advisory groups to help
5 coordinate the requirements under this section with other training programs for
6 incinerator operators."

7 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
