1 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT THE NORTH CAROLINA ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL COMMISSION CONSIDER VARIOUS FACTORS 3 PRIOR TO GRANTING ABC PERMITS, TO LENGTHEN THE PERIOD OF 4 NOTICE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS, AND TO CLARIFY THAT NO NOTICE 5 NEED BE GIVEN TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS UNLESS THE PERMIT IS 6 7 PERMANENT. 8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 9 Section 1. G.S. 18B-901(c) reads as rewritten: Factors in Issuing Permit. – Before issuing a permit, the Commission shall be 10 "(c) satisfied that the applicant is a suitable person to hold an ABC permit and that the 11 location is a suitable place to hold the permit for which he has applied. To be a suitable 12 place, the establishment shall comply with all applicable building and fire codes. Other 13 factors the Commission may shall consider in determining whether the applicant and the 14 business location are suitable are: 15 The reputation, character, and criminal record of the applicant; 16 (1) The number of places already holding ABC permits within the (2)17 neighborhood; 18 19 Parking facilities and traffic conditions in the neighborhood; (3) 20 Kinds of businesses already in the neighborhood; (4) Whether the establishment is located within 50 feet of a church or 21 (5) public school or church school; 22

2	(7) The recommendations of the local governing body; and
3	(8) Any other evidence that would tend to show whether the
4	applicant would comply with the ABC laws and whether operation
5	of his business at that location would be detrimental to the
6	neighborhood."
7	Sec. 2. G.S. 18B-901(b) reads as rewritten:
8	"(b) Notice to Local Government. – Before issuing an <u>a retail</u> ABC permit, <u>other</u>
9	than a:
10	(1) Special occasion permit under G.S. 18B-1001(8);
11	(2) Limited special occasion permit under G.S. 18B-1001(9);
12	(3) <u>Temporary permit under G.S. 18B-905; or</u>
13	(4) Special one-time permit under G.S. 18B-1002
14	for an establishment, the Commission shall give notice of the permit application to the
15	governing body of the city in which the establishment is located. If the establishment is
16	not inside a city, the Commission shall give notice to the governing body of the county.
17	The Commission shall allow the local governing body 10-15 days from the time the
18	notice was mailed or delivered to file written objection to the issuance of the permit. To
19	be considered by the Commission, the objection shall state the facts upon which it is
20	based."
21	Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification, but only applies to permits
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22 applied for on or after that date.
