A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY COMMISSION FROM
ESTABLISHING A DATA PROCESSING CENTER SEPARATE FROM THE
STATE INFORMATION PROCESSING SERVICES DATA CENTER.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Employment Security Commission shall not, before December 31, 1994, spend funds to design, develop, or implement a mainframe data processing center or mainframe data processing centers separate from the mainframe data processing center operated by the State Information Processing Services without prior approval of the Information Resource Management Commission. The Employment Security Commission shall notify the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations immediately if it seeks approval to design, develop, or implement a mainframe data processing center separate from State Information Processing Services. The Information Resource Management Commission shall submit a report of its action on the Employment Security Commission request for approval to the next meeting of the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations that occurs after it gives any such approval.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
