AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT INFORMATION ON RABIES VACCINATION CERTIFICATES IS NOT PUBLIC.

Section 1. G.S. 130A-189 reads as rewritten:

"§ 130A-189. Rabies vaccination certificates.

A licensed veterinarian or a certified rabies vaccinator who administers rabies vaccine to a dog or cat shall complete a three-copy rabies vaccination certificate. The original rabies vaccination certificate shall be given to the owner of each dog or cat that receives rabies vaccine. One copy of the rabies vaccination certificate shall be retained by the licensed veterinarian or the certified rabies vaccinator. The other copy shall be given to the county agency responsible for animal control. The information contained in the rabies vaccination certificate is not a public record nor shall it be released except upon authorization of the county health director for public health purposes."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1993.
