A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A ROTATING PROGRAM TO SURVEY

AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION IN SPECIALTY CROPS AND PRODUCTION INPUTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture the sum of one hundred thirty thousand four hundred dollars (\$130,400) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thirty-four thousand six hundred dollars (\$134,600) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for a rotating program to survey turfgrass, equine, pesticides, orchards and vineyards, and miscellaneous specialty commodities. This survey shall eliminate inconsistencies in maintaining these statistics and benefit the producer, agribusinessman, and consumer by providing information on production, prices, and other relevant economic data.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
