A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CRIME CONTROL AND PUBLIC SAFETY FOR DEVELOPMENT OF A STATEWIDE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to develop a system that links together criminal data in existing data bases and networks.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
