CHAPTER 11
HOUSE BILL 121

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE HUNTING OF DEER WITH MUZZLE-LOADING RIFLES OF ANY CALIBER DURING MUZZLE-LOADING DEER SEASON IN SCOTLAND COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 1143 of the 1959 Session Laws reads as rewritten:

"Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt deer with a rifle of larger bore than twenty-two (.22) ~~caliber~~-caliber, except in Scotland County during the muzzle-loading firearm deer season as established by the Wildlife Resources Commission."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 13th day of March, 1995.
