CHAPTER 55 HOUSE BILL 343

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE LAW ON HUNTING WITH DOGS IN ANSON COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter 231 of the Session Laws of 1987 reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 113-291.2 and regulations issued pursuant thereto, the season for hunting deer with firearms in Anson County shall last seven weeks. During the season for hunting deer with firearms in Anson County, deer may be hunted with the aid of dogs <u>east of North Carolina Highway 742</u> only during the last five weeks of the season, subject to the restrictions of G.S. 113-291.5(b) and the regulations issued pursuant thereto. <u>The hunting of deer with dogs in Anson County west of Highway 742 is prohibited.</u>"

Sec. 2. This act applies only to Anson County.

Sec. 3. This act is effective on ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 1st day of May, 1995.
