( <u>4)</u>	out; and The person is not a student enrolled at the school to which the school

bus provides transportation."

	Sec. 2. Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section
to read:	

## "§ 14-34.5. Assault on school bus driver and others.

Any person, who is not a student, who without lawful permission or authority boards a school bus and commits a physical assault upon a school bus driver, school bus monitor, or school employee who is boarding the school bus or who is on the school bus, is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor."

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 1995, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
