SALISBURY AND CABARRUS, CUMBERLAND AND GUILFORD COUNTIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 285 of the 1991 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 845 of the 1991 Session Laws, Chapter 642 of the 1993 Session Laws, and Chapter 95 of the 1995 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

- "Sec. 2. This act applies to Brunswick, <u>Cabarrus</u>, Catawba, <u>Cumberland</u>, Dare, <u>Guilford</u>, Johnston, Lincoln, Orange, and Pamlico Counties and the Cities of Chapel Hill, Carrboro, <u>Concord</u>, Conover, <u>Greensboro</u>, <u>Hickory</u>, <u>High Point</u>, <u>Lincolnton</u>, <u>and Newton Newton</u>, and <u>Salisbury</u> only."
- Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
