AN ACT TO EXEMPT THE CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG, FRANKLIN,

JOHNSTON, AND NASH SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS FROM

CERTAIN STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS IN SOME SCHOOL

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Charlotte-Mecklenburg School Administrative Unit may contract for the design and construction of the following capital improvement projects, planned by the County, without being subject to the requirements of G.S. 143-128(a) and (b), 143-129, 143-131, and 143-132:

- (1) Design, construct, and equip one new high school and one new elementary school.
- (2) Design, construct, and equip three expansion or renovation projects to existing school facilities.

This authorization includes, if deemed appropriate by the Board of Education, the use of design-build services as an alternative construction and delivery method.

Sec. 1.1 (a) A local school administrative unit may contract for the design and construction of the following capital improvement projects, planned by the county in

which the unit is located	, without being subject to the requiremen	ts of G.S.	143-128(a)
and (b), 143-129, 143-13	1, and 143-132:		

- (1) Design, construct, and equip new schools.
- (2) Design, construct, and equip expansion or renovation projects to existing school facilities.
- This authorization includes, if deemed appropriate by the Board of Education, the use of design-build services as an alternative construction and delivery method.
- (b) This section applies only to the Franklin, Johnston, and Nash County School Administrative Units.
- Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and expires on December 31, 1997.
