A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PERMIT LOCAL PURCHASE OF SUPPLIES BY THE GUILFORD
COUNTY SCHOOLS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 143-55, a State agency, public school unit, or community college may purchase from a local vendor the same good or service that is listed on a State requirements contract, when the local vendor is not certified on the State contract for that good or service only if the cost of each item is less than the contract price.

This section does not impair the contractual terms and conditions of State term contracts that allow purchases to be made from noncertified sources without meeting the requirements of this section.

Sec. 2. This act applies to the Guilford County Schools only.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
