7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	Section 1. G.S. 113-331 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
9	"(3a) <u>'Critical habitat' means an area designated by the Secretary of the</u>
10	United States Department of the Interior pursuant to 16 U.S.C. §
11	<u>1533.</u> "
12	Sec. 2. G.S. 113-333(3) reads as rewritten:
13	"(3) To coordinate development and implementation of conservation
14	programs for endangered and threatened species of wild animals and
15	for species of special concern; concern, provided that the
16	Commission shall not designate critical habitats, nor shall the
17	conservation programs adopted by the Commission be written so as
18	to impose restrictions upon, or limit the use of, private property by
19	any landholder."

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1	Sec. 3. G.S. 113-336(5) reads as rewritten:
2	"(5) To recommend critical habitat areas for protection or acquisition;
3	voluntary acquisition of critical habitats, to recommend adoption of
4	protective measures on lands owned or controlled by the
5	Commission which lie within critical habitats, and to recommend
6	voluntary protective measure agreements with landholders whose
7	property lies within critical habitats."
8	Sec. 4. G.S. 143-214.1 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
9	"(6) In assigning new, revised, or supplemental classifications to any
10	identified water, the Commission shall independently consider all
11	factors provided in this subdivision and shall not, by rule or
12	otherwise, base that assignment on the categorization, designation,
13	or other characterization of critical habitat by a local, State, or
14	federal agency, including designations by the Secretary of the United
15	States Department of the Interior."
16	Sec. 5. This act is effective upon ratification.
