A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO TRANSFER CHINQUA-PENN PLANTATION FROM THE
UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL
RESOURCES.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The mansion and mansion grounds known as Chinqua-Penn Plantation in Rockingham County are transferred from The University of North Carolina to the Department of Cultural Resources. The site transferred is approximately 22 acres and includes all the land and buildings together with property installed in the buildings. The statutory authority, powers, duties and functions, records, personnel, property, and unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, or other funds for Chinqua-Penn Plantation are transferred from The University of North Carolina to the Department of Cultural Resources.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
