- 2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
- 3 STUDY LONG-TERM CARE INSURANCE.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission shall study the availability, 5 coverage, and provision of long-term care insurance in North Carolina and may make 6 recommendations to overcome any barriers to the provision of private long-term care 7 The Legislative Research Commission may investigate the 8 insurance coverage. relationship between Medicaid, Medicare, and long-term care insurance; whether private 9 long-term care coverage can provide some relief to the increasing public burden of 10 Medicaid cost escalation; whether to mandate long-term insurance coverage; 11 impediments to product development; whether the State could promote product purchase; 12 and minimum standards of coverage. The Legislative Research Commission may consult 13 with the Commissioner of Insurance, the insurance industry, the long-term care industry, 14 15 and senior citizens' groups.

16 Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report to 17 the 1995 General Assembly, 1996 Regular Session, and shall make a final report to the 18 1997 General Assembly.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
