Short Title: Nursing Home Administrators Act Fees.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF CERTAIN FEES SET BY THE NORTH
CAROLINA STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS FOR NURSING HOME
ADMINISTRATORS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 90-280 reads as rewritten:

"§ 90-280. Fees; display of license; duplicate license; inactive list.

(a) Each applicant for an examination administered by the Board and each applicant for an administrator-in-training program shall pay a fee set by the Board not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200.00).

(b) Each person licensed as a nursing home administrator shall be required to pay a license fee in an amount set by the Board not to exceed ~~two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00)~~ five hundred dollars (\$500.00). A license shall expire on the thirtieth day of September of the second year following its issuance and shall be renewable biennially upon payment of a renewal fee set by the Board not to exceed ~~two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00)~~ five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

(c) Each person licensed as a nursing home administrator shall display his license certificate, along with the current certificate of renewal, in a conspicuous place in ~~his~~ the person's place of employment.

1 (d) Any person licensed as a nursing home administrator may receive a duplicate
2 license by payment of a fee set by the Board not to exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).

3 (e) Any person licensed as a nursing home administrator who is not acting,
4 serving, or holding ~~himself~~-out to be a nursing home administrator may have ~~his~~-the
5 person's name placed on an inactive list for ~~such a~~ period of time not to exceed five years
6 upon payment of a fee set by the Board not to exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).

7 (f) Any person having a temporary license issued pursuant to G.S. 90-278(3) shall
8 pay a fee in an amount set by the Board not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00). If
9 the Board renews the temporary license, no further fee shall be required.

10 (g) The Board may set fees not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) for
11 conducting and administering initial training and continuing education courses, and may
12 set a fee not to exceed ~~twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)~~ one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for
13 certifying a course submitted for review by another individual or agency wishing to offer
14 ~~such~~-these courses."

15 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1995, and applies to fees due on
16 or after that date.
