Referred to: Appropriations February 27, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR TEEN INVOLVEMENT PROJECTS (TIPS) IN CUMBERLAND COUNTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Teen Involvement Projects (TIPS) a nonprofit corporation in Cumberland County, the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year for the purpose of enhancing its juvenile delinquency prevention programs which include the Male Involvement Prevention Project for Boys, the Teens Against Pressure, the Caring Adults and Parent

Support Group, the Theatre-Arts Productions (STEPS), the Sports Programs, the Drill

Teams (POSITIVE FORCE), and the Models Program.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
