A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE HOUSING COORDINATION  
AND POLICY COUNCIL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 122A-5.11 reads as rewritten:

**"§ 122A-5.11. Council membership; compensation; procedures.**

(a) The Housing Coordination and Policy Council shall consist of 15 representatives, as follows:

- (1) ~~Two members~~ One member of the N.C. Housing Partnership who ~~are~~ is experienced with housing programs for low-income persons, as designated by the chair.
- (2) ~~Two members~~ One member of the Community Development Council who ~~are~~ is experienced with federal, State, and local housing programs, as designated by the chair.
- (3) ~~Two members~~ One member of the N.C. Housing Finance Agency Board of Directors who ~~are~~ is experienced with real estate finance and development, as designated by the chair.
- (4) One member of the Weatherization Policy Advisory Council who is experienced with community weatherization programs, as designated by the chair.

- 1 (5) One member of the Governor's Advocacy Council for Persons with  
2 Disabilities who is familiar with the housing needs of the disabled.
- 3 (6) The executive director of the Commission of Indian Affairs, or a  
4 designee familiar with Indian housing programs.
- 5 (7) ~~The Deputy Secretary or Assistant Secretary of Community Development~~  
6 ~~and Housing, or a designee familiar with housing programs related to~~  
7 ~~community development and housing functions.~~
- 8 (8) ~~The assistant secretary-director of the Division of Aging, or a designee~~  
9 ~~familiar with the housing programs of the Division.~~
- 10 (9) The executive director of the N.C. Housing Finance Agency, or a  
11 designee familiar with the housing programs of the Agency.
- 12 (10) The director of the Division of Mental Health, or a designee familiar  
13 with housing for those with mental disabilities.
- 14 (11) The executive director of the N.C. Human Relations Commission, or a  
15 designee familiar with federal and State fair housing laws.
- 16 (12) ~~A chair designated by the Governor.~~ The head of the AIDS Care Branch,  
17 or a designee familiar with the housing programs of the Division of  
18 Adult Health Promotion.
- 19 (13) The director of the Office of Economic Opportunity, or a designee  
20 familiar with programs for the homeless.
- 21 (14) Two members of nonprofit organizations who are experienced with  
22 housing advocacy for low-income persons and State and federal housing  
23 programs.

24 (b) All members except those serving ex officio shall be appointed by the  
25 Governor. The Governor shall designate one member of the Council to serve as Chair.

26 (c) The initial members of the Council other than those serving ex officio shall be  
27 appointed to serve for terms of four years and until their successors are appointed and  
28 qualified. Any appointment to fill a vacancy created by resignation, dismissal, death, or  
29 disability of a member shall be for the balance of the term.

30 (d) Members of the Council may receive per diem and necessary travel and  
31 subsistence expenses in accordance with the provisions of G.S. 138-5.

32 (e) A majority of the Council shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of  
33 business.

34 (f) All clerical and other services required by the Council shall be supplied by the  
35 Housing Finance Agency."

36 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
