Referred to: Local Government and Regional Affairs April 11, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT CHANGING THE ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE MCDOWELL COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION FROM MAY TO NOVEMBER. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 322 of the 1987 Session Laws reads as rewritten: "Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 115C-37, the McDowell County Board of Education shall be elected on a nonpartisan basis at the time of the primary set by G.S. 163-1 for the general election in 1988-1996 and biennially thereafter. The names of the candidates shall be printed on the ballot without reference to any party affiliations. The nonpartisan election and runoff-plurality election method shall be used with the results determined as provided in G.S. 163-293, except that the runoff shall be held on the date provided by G.S. 163-111(e).-G.S. 163-292." Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
