1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED	
2	AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PENALTIES FOR VOLUNTARY MANSLAUGHTER,	
3	POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE IN A CONFINEMENT	
4	FACILITY AND POSSESSION WITH INTENT TO SELL AND DELIVER	
5	MARIJUANA.	
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
7	Section 1. G.S. 14-18 reads as rewritten:	
8	"§ 14-18. Punishment for manslaughter.	
9	Voluntary manslaughter shall be punishable as a Class <u>E-D</u> felony, and involuntary	
10	manslaughter shall be punishable as a Class F felony."	
11	Sec. 2. G.S. 90-95(e)(9) reads as rewritten:	
12	"(9) Any person who violates G.S. 90-95(a)(3) on the premises of a penal	
13	institution or local confinement facility shall be guilty of a Class $I-G$	
14	felony."	
15	Sec. 3. G.S. 90-95(h)(1) reads as rewritten:	
16	"(1) Any person who sells, manufactures, delivers, transports, or possesses	
17	in excess of 50-10 pounds (avoirdupois) of marijuana shall be guilty of a	
18	felony which felony shall be known as 'trafficking in marijuana' and if	
19	the quantity of such substance involved:	
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1	a.	Is in excess of 50-10 pounds, but less than 100 pounds, such	
2		person shall be punished as a Class H felon and shall be	
3		sentenced to a minimum term of 25 months and a maximum term	
4		of 30 months in the State's prison and shall be fined not less than	
5		five thousand dollars (\$5,000);	
6	b.	Is 100 pounds or more, but less than 2,000 pounds, such person	
7		shall be punished as a Class G felon and shall be sentenced to a	
8		minimum term of 35 months and a maximum term of 42 months	
9		in the State's prison and shall be fined not less than twenty-five	
10		thousand dollars (\$25,000);	
11	С.	Is 2,000 pounds or more, but less than 10,000 pounds, such	
12		person shall be punished as a Class F felon and shall be	
13		sentenced to a minimum term of 70 months and a maximum term	
14		of 84 months in the State's prison and shall be fined not less than	
15		fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000);	
16	d.	Is 10,000 pounds or more, such person shall be punished as a	
17		Class D felon and shall be sentenced to a minimum term of 175	
18		months and a maximum term of 219 months in the State's prison	
19		and shall be fined not less than two hundred thousand dollars	
20		(\$200,000)."	
21	Sec. 4. This	act becomes effective December 1, 1995, and applies to offenses	
22	committed on or after that date.
