A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO RESTRICT FORMER LEGISLATORS FROM LOBBYING FOR TWO YEARS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Article 9A of Chapter 120 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 120-47.12. Lobbying by former State legislators restricted.

Until two years after a member of either house of the General Assembly has ceased to be a member of either house, that person may not engage in any employment or other activity which would require registration as a lobbyist under this Article."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law, and applies to any person who is a member of either the Senate or House of Representatives on or after that date.
