A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE STOKES COUNTY MOUNTAIN
RESCUE TEAM TO IMPLEMENT THE CARE TRAK SYSTEM IN AN ELEVEN
COUNTY REGION.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to The Stokes County Mountain Rescue Team, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of one hundred forty-one thousand four hundred dollars (\$141,400) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to enable The Stokes County Mountain Rescue Team to implement the Care Trak System in Surry, Stokes, Rockingham, Guilford, Randolph, Forsyth, Davidson, Davie, Iredell, Yadkin, and Wilkes Counties. The Care Trak System uses electronic transmitters to locate missing persons with such illnesses as Alzheimer's Disease, Down Syndrome, Traumatic Brain Injury, or Autism.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
