A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW CITIES AND COUNTIES TO ADOPT ORDINANCES THAT
IMPOSE A CURFEW ON PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Article 8 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes is amended by
adding a new section to read:

"§ 160A-198. Curfews.

A city may by ordinance impose a curfew on persons under the age of 18."

Section 2. Article 6 of Chapter 153A of the General Statutes is amended by
adding a new section to read:

"§ 153A-142. Curfews.

A county may by ordinance impose a curfew on persons under the age of 18."

Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
