April 3, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF SHALLOTTE TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN TO ENFORCE ORDINANCES AS PROVIDED IN THE GENERAL LAW. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Section 9 of the Charter of Shallotte, being Chapter 339 of the Public Laws of 1899, reads as rewritten: "Sec. 9. Violations. Any person violating any ordinance of said town shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, but the punishment thereof upon conviction shall not exceed a fine of \$50 or imprisonment for 30 days. The provisions of G.S. 160A-175 govern violations and enforcement of ordinances adopted by the Board of Aldermen." Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
