A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE INVESTIGATIONS OF
SUDDEN UNEXPECTED DEATHS OF INFANTS AND YOUNG CHILDREN
(SUD PROGRAM), AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CHILD FATALITY TASK
FORCE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Women's and Children's Health, Department of Health and Human Services, the sum of one hundred ninety thousand four hundred dollars (\$190,400) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to start up and operate improved, intensive investigation of sudden unexpected deaths of infants and young children. These investigations shall include adequate death scene examinations and historical inquiry as well as autopsies, with appropriate ancillary studies.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
