A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR
2 PROGRAMS THAT MAY BE ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD OF
3 GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 116-74.21(b) reads as rewritten:

7 "(b) No more than ~~eight~~nine school administrator programs shall be established
8 under the competitive proposal program. In selecting campus sites, the Board of
9 Governors shall be sensitive to the racial, cultural, and geographic diversity of the State.
10 Special priority shall be given to the following factors: (i) the historical background of
11 the institutions in training educators; (ii) the ability of the sites to serve the geographic
12 regions of the State, such as, the far west, the west, the triad, the piedmont, and the east;
13 and, (iii) whether the type of roads and terrain in a region make commuting difficult. A
14 school administrator program may provide for instruction at one or more campus sites."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
