The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 150B-21.8(c) reads as rewritten:

- "(c) Scope. When the Commission reviews an amendment to a rule, it may review only the amendment that is submitted for approval. It shall not review the entire rule that is being amended. The procedure in G.S. 150B-21.12 applies when the Commission objects to a part of a rule that is within its scope of review but is not changed by a rule amendment."
- Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to all amendments to rules for which the Rules Review Commission has not made a determination on or after that date regarding its approval.
