9	grant, reserve, or declare valid easements, restrictions, or conditions of record burdening
10	or benefiting the same interest in real property.
11	(b) Subsection (a) of this section shall not affect the application of the doctrine of
12	merger after the severance and subsequent reunification of title to all of the benefited or
13	burdened real property or interests therein."
14	Section 2. This act is effective October 1, 1997, and applies to all easements,
15	restrictions, conditions, or interests created, granted, reserved, or declared before, on, or
16	after the effective date of this act but shall not apply to any litigation pending on the
