April 16, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO BE USED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT GREENSBORO TO EQUIP THE SCHOOL OF MUSIC AND FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW SCIENCE BUILDING. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to equip the new School of Music on the campus of the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of nine million nine hundred eighteen thousand dollars (\$9,918,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year for capital costs relating to the new science building on the campus of the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. These funds shall be allocated as follows: Site preparation and the purchase of (1) remaining properties needed for the site \$1,500,000 Installation of underground utilities (2) Site development of the future **(3)** "science quad" \$1,568,000
