A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL
RESOURCES FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA TRANSPORTATION MUSEUM
LOCATED IN SPENCER.**

Whereas, the North Carolina Transportation Museum needs funds for repairs, renovation, and preservation of the historic Back Shop for future expansion of the museum to interpret all modes of transportation; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources, Division of Archives and History, the sum of three million one hundred thousand dollars (\$3,100,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year for capital improvements at the North Carolina Transportation Museum (Historic Spencer Shops).

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
