Section 7 of Chapter 539 of the 1995 Session Laws, as amended by 5 Section 15.1(b) of Chapter 17 of the Session Laws of the 1996 Second Extra Session, 6 7 reads as rewritten: 8 "Sec. 7. Effective July 1, 1997, July 1, 1998, G.S. 55-14-22(a), as amended by Section 9 6 of this act, reads as rewritten: A corporation administratively dissolved under G.S. 55-14-21 may apply to the 10 Secretary of State for reinstatement within two years after the effective date of 11

- dissolution. The application must:
  - Recite the name of the corporation and the effective date of its (1) administrative dissolution; and
  - State that the ground or grounds for dissolution either did not exist or (2) have been eliminated.

- "(b) Section 7 of this act becomes effective July 1, 1997, July 1, 1998, and applies to applications for reinstatement on or after that date. Section 25 of this act becomes effective July 1, 1996, and applies to proceedings commenced on or after that date."
  - Section 3. This act becomes effective June 30, 1997.
