A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INCREASE EFFORTS FOR THE 3 PREVENTION OF AIDS/HIV.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 6 Health and Human Services, Division of Health, the sum of one million dollars 7 (\$1,000,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of one million dollars 8 (\$1,000,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for community-based intervention efforts to 9 combat the AIDS/HIV epidemic. Funds appropriated under this section shall be allocated 10 as follows:

- (1) \$300,000 each fiscal year to increase, by over 600,000 persons, the
 capacity of existing community-based organizations to provide outreach
 services to individuals at risk for HIV/AIDS;
- 14 (2) \$300,000 each fiscal year to increase the capacity of local health 15 departments in counties where increased community-based organization 16 efforts occur for the examination and treatment of persons referred by 17 the community-based organizations and to establish alternate counseling 18 and testing sites that are based either at the local health department or at 19 the community-based organization; and

(3) \$400,000 each fiscal year to provide funding for the development of new community-based organizations to provide outreach and referral services for persons at risk for HIV/AIDS. The primary focus of no fewer than one-half of the community-based organizations developed with funds allocated by this subdivision shall be services to racial and ethnic minority populations across the State.
7 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
