1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO EXCLUDE FEDERAL CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR
3 QUALITY FUNDS FROM THE DISTRIBUTION FORMULA FOR FUNDS
4 EXPENDED ON TRANSPORTATION.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 136-17.2A(a) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a) Funds expended for the Intrastate System projects listed in G.S. 136-179 and
8 both State and federal-aid funds expended under the Transportation Improvement
9 Program, other than federal congestion mitigation and air quality improvement program
10 funds appropriated to the State by the United States pursuant to 23 U.S.C. § 104(b)(2)
11 and 23 U.S.C. § 149, funds expended on an urban loop project listed in G.S. 136-180 and
12 funds received through competitive awards or discretionary grants through federal
13 appropriations either for local governments, transportation authorities, transit authorities,
14 or the Department, shall be distributed throughout the State in accordance with this
15 section.

16 (1) Distribution Region A consists of the following counties: Bertie,
17 Camden, Chowan, Currituck, Dare, Edgecombe, Gates, Halifax,
18 Hertford, Hyde, Johnston, Martin, Nash, Northampton, Pasquotank,
19 Perquimans, Tyrrell, Washington, Wayne, and Wilson.

- 1 (2) Distribution Region B consists of the following counties: Beaufort,
2 Brunswick, Carteret, Craven, Duplin, Greene, Jones, Lenoir, New
3 Hanover, Onslow, Pamlico, Pender, Pitt, and Sampson.
- 4 (3) Distribution Region C consists of the following counties: Bladen,
5 Columbus, Cumberland, Durham, Franklin, Granville, Harnett, Person,
6 Robeson, Vance, Wake, and Warren.
- 7 (4) Distribution Region D consists of the following counties: Alamance,
8 Caswell, Davidson, Davie, Forsyth, Guilford, Orange, Rockingham,
9 Rowan, and Stokes.
- 10 (5) Distribution Region E consists of the following counties: Anson,
11 Cabarrus, Chatham, Hoke, Lee, Mecklenburg, Montgomery, Moore,
12 Randolph, Richmond, Scotland, Stanly, and Union.
- 13 (6) Distribution Region F consists of the following counties: Alexander,
14 Alleghany, Ashe, Avery, Caldwell, Catawba, Cleveland, Gaston, Iredell,
15 Lincoln, Surry, Watauga, Wilkes, and Yadkin.
- 16 (7) Distribution Region G consists of the following counties: Buncombe,
17 Burke, Cherokee, Clay, Graham, Haywood, Henderson, Jackson,
18 Macon, Madison, McDowell, Mitchell, Polk, Rutherford, Swain,
19 Transylvania, and Yancey."

20 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
