| 8  | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  |
| 9  | Section 1. G.S. 111-42 reads as rewritten:  |
| 10 | "§ 111-42. Definitions as used in this Article.   |
| 11 | (a) 'Regular vending facility' means a vending facility where food preparation or         |
| 12 | cooking is not done on the State property.  |
| 13 | (b) 'State agency' means department, commission, agency or instrumentality of the         |
| 14 | State.  |
| 15 | (c) 'State property or State building' means building and land owned, leased, or          |
| 16 | otherwise controlled by the State, exclusive of schools, colleges and universities, the   |
| 17 | North Carolina State Fair, the North Carolina Aquariums, and the State Legislative        |
| 18 | Building.   |
| 19 | (d) 'Vending facility' includes a snack bar, cafeteria, restaurant, cafe, concession      |
| 20 | stand, vending stand, cart service, or other facilities at which food, drinks, novelties, |

newspapers, periodicals, confections, souvenirs, tobacco products or related items are regularly sold. 'Visually handicapped' means a person who is totally blind or whose vision (e) with glasses is so defective as to prevent the performance of ordinary activity for which evesight is essential and who is registered pursuant to G.S. 111-4." Section 2. Part 5C of Article 7 of Chapter 143B of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ G.S. 143B-289.45. Proceeds from food and vending services. The net proceeds of revenue generated by food and vending services that are provided at the North Carolina Aquariums and are operated by or whose operation is contracted for by the Division of North Carolina Aquariums shall be deposited in the North Carolina Aquariums Fund." Section 3. This act shall not be construed to alter any contract for food and vending services at the North Carolina Aquariums that is in force at the time this act becomes law. Section 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
