A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR AREA MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAMS. 2 Whereas, funds for area mental health, developmental disabilities, and substance abuse services programs have been reduced over the past eight years in an amount over sixteen million dollars: and

Whereas, reductions in funds have resulted in curtailment of needed services for people with disabilities in North Carolina; Now, therefore,

- The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 3 4
 - Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and
- 5 Substance Abuse Services, the sum of sixteen million dollars (\$16,000,000) for the 1999-6
- 2000 fiscal year and the sum of sixteen million dollars (\$16,000,000) for the 2000-2001 7
- fiscal year for area mental health, developmental disabilities, and substance abuse 8
- programs. These funds shall be allocated based on a formula established to address the 9
- waiting list for services for each disability area. 10 11
 - Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
