The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The total funds appropriated in the State budget to any State department or agency for indigent defense for any fiscal year may not exceed the total funds appropriated for that fiscal year for district attorneys' offices across the State. For purposes of this act, "indigent defense"includes fees for private attorneys, appellate defender services, public defender services, the Guardian Ad Litem program, provision of special counsel to the mentally ill, and the grant to the North Carolina State Bar.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
