5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 132-6.1(c) reads as rewritten:
7	"(c) Nothing in this section shall require a public agency to create a computer
8	database that the public agency has not otherwise created or is not otherwise required to
9	be created. Nothing in this section requires a public agency to disclose its software
10	security, including passwords. for public inspection or copying records concerning its
11	hardware or software security, passwords, security standards, procedures, processes,
12	configurations, software, codes, or other information that would allow unauthorized
13	access to electronic data processing systems, information technology systems or
14	electronic security systems."
15	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
