A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT CLEVELAND CORRECTIONAL CENTER SHALL
REMAIN OPEN.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The General Assembly finds that Cleveland Correctional Center has provided the State prison system with a site for the secure confinement of medium-custody inmates in a cost-efficient manner, has provided a steady source of employment for citizens of Cleveland and surrounding counties and has produced significant economic benefits for those counties, and has developed a long-standing cooperative relationship with Cleveland Community College for the provision of vocational education programs to inmates.

Section 2. The Cleveland Correctional Center shall not be closed during the 1999-2001 biennium, but shall remain in operation as a medium-custody facility in the State prison system.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
