13	(2) It ha	s no more than two paid members and otherwise consists of volunteer	
14	mem	bers. It consists entirely of volunteer members, with the exception	
15	<u>that</u>	the unit may have paid members to fill the equivalent of three full-	
16	time	paid positions.	
17	(3) It ha	s been certified by the Department of Insurance.

8		(2)	It has no more than two paid members and otherwise consists of volunteer
9			members. It consists entirely of volunteer members, with the exception

12		(3)	It has been recognized by the Department as an organization that
13			provides rescue or rescue and emergency medical services.
14		(4)	It satisfies the eligibility criteria established by the Department under
15			subsection (a) of this section."
