A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT A HOME AND COMMUNITY-BASED MEDICAID WAIVER FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH TRAUMATIC BRAIN

INJURY.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of one million five hundred one thousand three hundred three dollars (\$1,501,303) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of one million five hundred one thousand three hundred three dollars (\$1,501,303) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to match federal and local funds to support a Home and Community-Based Medicaid Waiver for approximately 100 individuals with Traumatic Brain Injury. Of these funds, one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) in each fiscal year may be used for administrative support to manage the waiver.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
